



With tranquil lakes, vibrant wetlands, and miles of hiking and biking trails, there's no shortage of outdoor adventures. Paddle along our waterways, encounter diverse wildlife, or simply take in the stars —our clear, open skies make Dexter one of the best spots in the Bootheel for stargazing. When you visit Dexter, make plans to explore the great outdoors.

If you're looking for a serene spot nestled right in the heart of Dexter, then you're in luck. Dexter City Lake offers a natural retreat for both visitors and locals. Our Dexter Parks and Recreation Department and the Missouri Department of Conservation maintain the fish population, making it a popular destination for anglers. With opportunities to spot turtles, ducks, and other wildlife, Dexter City Lake is for nature lovers of all ages.





Otter Slough Conservation

Area is one of only a few
examples of a cypress/tupelo
swamp left in Missouri and is
home to thousands of migrating
waterfowl. Although the 4,866acre area is managed primarily for
migratory and wintering waterfowl,
many wading birds, shorebirds,
eagles, and wetland mammals also
make this area their home.

Holly Ridge Conservation Area offers nearly 85 acres of streams and forested hills ideal for hiking, horseback riding, hunting, and wildlife observation. Visitors can explore trails winding through oak and hickory woods, where they can encounter deer, turkeys, and songbirds. With its peaceful setting and diverse wildlife, Holly Ridge is a perfect retreat for outdoor enthusiasts looking to experience the Bootheel's natural beauty.

Mingo National Wildlife Refuge is a premier destination in the Bootheel for nature lovers and outdoor adventurers alike. Explore miles of scenic wildlife drives, lush hiking trails, and winding waterways perfect for canoeing and kayaking through beautiful bottomland forests and wetlands. Mingo's diverse habitats offer prime locations for hunting, fishing, and birdwatching, with countless opportunities to spot unique wildlife. Immerse yourself in the natural beauty of the Bootheel at Mingo — an unforgettable escape into Missouri's wild side.
